When the dispatcher receives the request for an additional alarm, they will dispatch the units specified for the alarm called for.

The dispatcher will make the all hands a notification, regardless of what alarm is called for.

If the unit on scene skips an alarm level, the units for that skipped alarm level should also be dispatched.

When a multiple alarm is requested the alarm will be toned out over Cape Elizabeth Fire Frequency & State Fire Frequency.

The dispatchers will also **Pagegate the following groups: Engine One Company, Engine Two Company, and the Chiefs.**
